The summer school will bring together young professionals working in the psycho-traumatology field for a week of career development and tuition. Participants will meet new colleagues from across Europe and will have ample opportunity to liaise with established and highly renowned academics working in the field. Together participants will discuss how to get published, how to apply for research funding and how to build a collaborative research network. All participants will be able to share their own areas of research and will be offered small group-based tuition with experienced academics who can provide advice on a wide array of research matters.

There will be an initial social day titled 'knowing me, knowing you' in which participants can meet in a relaxed and fun filled environment which will include a trip to the Giants Causeway, a lunch, and an evening meal. The final day will focus on collaboration within the group and together participants will plan future activities such as conference symposium, publications and / or funding applications.

- **30 places available**

Places will be awarded based on the quality of the applicant's proposals (see below).

Decisions will also take into account applicants country of origin, this will ensure greater diversity.

- **Funded places available**

A number of funded places will be available.

These will include registration, travel and accommodation.

- **Registration fee - £300**

including lunches, tuition and the social events

Travel & accommodation costs will be the responsibility of the candidate.

Subsidised student accommodation is available at £140 for 5 nights..

Proposals should be structured as follows:

1. Details on the candidates Name, Gender, Programme and Year of Study, Principle Supervisor details, & Host Institution.
2. How candidate's participation in the summer school will benefit them personally
3. How candidate's participation in the summer school will benefit them professionally
4. Details of the main topic and focus of the candidate's research programme (theoretical & methodological) and the stage or progress in which the work currently is.

Proposals should not exceed 2 pages of Ariel font, size 12.
