

Dr Brock Chisholm



Dr Brock Chisholm is a Clinical Psychologist who works with victims of human rights violations. He is Director of *Criterion A Psychology Services*, a small organization providing psychological expertise for survivors of traumatic events such as such as torture, trafficking, sexual violence, war and rendition. He is the lead psychologist on a large international war crimes investigation and has acted as consultant or expert witness in a variety of issues including CIA black sites, MI6 renditions, undercover police abuse, slavery, trafficking, torture and sexual crimes.

He is an approved expert in for the *Preventing Sexual Violence Initiative* hosted by the *Foreign and Commonwealth Office* and provides expertise to the *National Crime Agency*. He is a UKPTS board; lecturer at the *Royal Hospital for Tropical Medicine*; and trainer for the *Metropolitan Police* in *The Sexual Offences, Child Abuse and Exploitation Command*.

Brock has previously been employed at specialist NHS services for people with a diagnosis of PTSD, including *The Traumatic Stress Clinic* and *The Forced Migration Trauma Service* in London.

Polly Rossdale



Polly Rossdale is an independent human rights consultant, specialising in asylum and human rights advocacy, research and project coordination. Polly is currently coordinating care for refugee torture survivors in Greece as a consultant for the international law firm *Reed Smith*. She is a Senior Researcher at *One World Research* where she conducts investigation and research on asylum and criminal defense cases and a trustee of the refugee education charity, the *Schwab Westheimer Trust*.

Polly was previously a Deputy Director at human rights charity *Reprieve*, where she coordinated a rehabilitation project for former Guantánamo detainees in Europe, North Africa and South America. As part of this work she established the first multidisciplinary torture rehabilitation services for torture survivors in post-revolution Tunisia, working with Dr Brock Chisholm to train a local team of clinicians and social workers.

Polly was previously employed with the *Helen Bamber Foundation*.

Brock and Polly are working with others to establish *Trauma Treatment International*. This charity will provide psychological interventions to victims of human rights abuses around the world
