

Conflict, peace and mental health: Addressing the consequences of conflict and trauma in Northern Ireland

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This workshop will take the form of a series of short presentations that (1) provides an overview of the mental health and related impact of the Troubles; (2) discusses how approaches to researching the impact of the Troubles changed over the 40 years of the conflict and what was learned; (3) explores the challenges of addressing and researching the impact of violence in the context of civil conflict; (4) Considers how addressing the mental health legacy of protracted conflict should form a key part of the peace-making project.
