

Dr Laura Toplis is a Principal Clinical Psychologist with the East of England Major Trauma Centre, based at Addenbrooke's Hospital, Cambridge. She has been in post since January 2013 and is based in the Liaison Psychiatry Service providing an inpatient and outpatient service, teaching and training and consultancy. She is an Executive Board Member of the UK Psychological Trauma Society (UKPTS), Visiting Lecturer to the Doctoral course at the University of East Anglia and was a member of the PTSD Evidence Update Advisory Group.

Previous to her current post she was the Educational Projects Manager for Trauma with the Psychological Interventions Team, funded by the Scottish Government and hosted with NHS Education for Scotland (NES). Her first post after qualifying was within a Primary Care Mental Health Team in Edinburgh. She completed her Doctorate at Glasgow University, with a thesis on vicarious traumatisation in Clinical Psychologists.
